

Minimum Device Specifications

Acceptable device guidelines – Apple iPad

While the *recommended* models will most likely be supported by Apple's iOS updates and the school for at least 3 years, the *acceptable* models list are older and we cannot guarantee that Apple will continue to support iOS updates for these devices. If you are thinking about purchasing an iPad, please choose from the *recommended* models only.

The device must be an Apple iPad that falls within the following guidelines.

Recommended models:

- iPad (5th Gen) 2017 model (9.7") or above
- iPad Mini 4 or above
- iPad Pro (all models)

Acceptable models:

- iPad Air
- iPad Air 2
- iPad Mini 2
- iPad Mini 3

iPad models that are **not acceptable** include the following:

- iPad (1st gen)
- iPad 2
- iPad 3
- iPad 4
- iPad Mini (1st gen)

While every effort has been made to keep this document current, we acknowledge that new technologies come about often and we will try to keep you updated on supported models as they are released.

It is a requirement that parents provide a tough-case for their child's device as well as insurance for the device. North Adelaide Primary School cannot accept responsibility for physical damage caused to a device while at school or while being used for a school activity. (Please check your Insurance Policy re mobile device coverage)

In accordance with DECD regulations, when a child finishes at NAPS, all devices must be wiped by the school before being returned to the parents. This is a simple process and can be accomplished easily by school IT staff.
