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Bring Your Own Device (Learning Enrichment Programme) Agreement

Our school has embraced a Bring Your Own Device (iPad) approach for enriching the learning of students and teachers. iPad devices are used to promote genuine learning, research, problem solving and positive communication. We support our students to become digitally responsible cyber citizens.

Please review and sign the B.Y.O.D. agreement between teachers, parents, and students of North Adelaide Primary School. No student will be permitted to use a personal iPad device until the agreement is signed and returned. The iPad must meet the minimum standard identified in the *Minimum Device Specifications* document.

Students participating in the B.Y.O.D. must adhere to the Acceptable Use Policy of North Adelaide Primary School. Please read the following statements carefully:

1. When submitted to the school at the start of the student's attendance, North Adelaide Primary School will enrol the device in their Mobile Device Management (MDM) Solution. This will configure the device for use at school and enact restrictions based on DECD policy on storage of student data. More information can be found in the Device Management Guide.
2. Without notice, North Adelaide Primary School reserves the right to collect, view and confiscate any device during school hours, or while a student is attending a school activity (excursion or school camp).
3. Students take full responsibility for their devices. The school is not responsible for security or physical damage caused to personal devices. Personal devices should not be left before or after school hours and be locked away if being stored in a classroom. Students' families are also responsible for the insurance of personal devices. (Please check your Insurance Policy re mobile device coverage)
4. Devices are not to be used outside the classroom, unless otherwise directed by the teacher.
5. Students must immediately comply with teachers' requests to shut down devices (lock screen). Devices must be in silent mode and put away when asked by the teacher.
6. In accordance with DECD policy, students are not permitted to transmit or post photographic images/videos of any person at school on public or social networks.
7. Personal devices must be charged prior to bringing them to school and run off their own batteries while at school.
8. To ensure appropriate network filters, students will only connect to the school wireless network as defined by the device configuration. Students are not permitted at any time to connect to their own personal cellular (3G/4G) or WiFi Service.
9. Students will not share their personal devices with other students. Only the student who brings the device may use it.
10. Students will be responsible for their personal device while at school. Many devices look identical. It is recommended that skins (decals) and other custom touches that meet the requirements of the Student Code of Conduct be used to physically distinguish devices from others.

If this agreement is broken, there will be appropriate consequences determined by the Principal or delegated person.
