The Advanced Skills classification was developed to recognise and reward highly skilled teachers. The AST2 classification is a merit selection process that requires teachers to demonstrate that they are exemplary and innovative teacher leaders who influence and improve the teaching and learning practice of their peers and subsequently improve learning outcomes for students. It is fantastic to have so many of our teachers recognised. We are very lucky to have such highly skilled staff at NAPS.

PATM and PATR Testing

Students from years 2-7 are currently involved in tests called the PATR and PATM tests. These are online standardised tests in reading comprehension and maths. The tests will provide us with the opportunity to analyse student's results to determine where support is required and to help us ensure our learning programs are tailored to suit students' needs.

OSHC NEWS

School Closure Day – OSHC will be open on the 7th September for the school closure day. If you require care for this day please book in as soon as possible to secure a place. Booking forms can be collected from OSHC or the front office and completing one is essential to participation.

Vacation Care – Bookings are now being taken for the October Vacation Care period. Vacation Care programs can be collected from the front office or OSHC to make a booking. The program is also on the school website. Please book by the 21st September to receive the reduced fee of \$47. After this cut-off date the daily fee for Vacation Care will be \$52.

Outstanding OSHC Fees – Please ensure that your OSHC account is up to date prior to the end of Term 3. If you have any concerns in regards to your account please see Deb. See below for payment options.

How to pay your OSHC fees – To access BPOINT, log onto the school website at the following address www.nthadelaideps.sa.edu.au and select [Pay your school fees online with ease](#) link.

When making an OSHC payment, enter the word “**OSHC**” in the field **Family Code/ED ID**, Students full name, invoice number (located on the left hand side of invoice) and amount. Please ensure that once the transaction is complete that a copy of the receipt or the transaction number is noted for your records.

KidsXap - Log in Instructions –

All OSHC families have a KidsXap account that can be logged into. Please see the following to assist you in logging into the web portal.

- Open the web portal using the link below.
- Click on “Forgot Username/Password”
- Enter Email ID which is linked to your child’s enrolment and Click “Submit”
- You will receive a reset password email. This email will contain a link which expires within a half an hour of receiving it.
- It is advised that you open it straight away.
- You will be able to create a new password by opening the link in that email.
- Open the centres portal
- You will now be able to login using your new password and email ID as Username.

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There is also a “**KidsXap Guardian**” App which is handy to have on your phone or portable device. The App has most of the same functions as the portal however when completing all enrolment information you will be need to do this on the web portal.

Completing Enrolments on KidsXap –

I have been checking the information in the “dashboard” under “your account” in KidsXap and would like to ask for your help to urgently complete the missing information yet to be entered. Please can you check, and if needed, complete the following sections (**please hit save after entering the new data**):

- **Guardian/Nominees:** Please add your emergency contacts under nominees in this tab with complete phone information, relationships and consents.
- **Children's tab:** At the bottom of this tab, you will find Health & Diet details. Please complete each section.
- **Declaration & Consent:** Please complete each question in this important section.

Please can I request that you complete the updates as soon as possible.

Functions – KidsXap has many great features. A few of those features are that you will be able to receive notifications of booking updates, illness/ incidents, notify of absences, make casual bookings and send messages to the Centre.

- **Manage Families –** Here you can update details as they change.
- **Attendances –** To add bookings press the green plus symbol, select date, choose “CWA” if claiming or intend on claiming CCS (Child Care Subsidy rebates) if not select “RA” and agree to the terms and conditions (those will be added shortly). Please note that at this stage only one session can be booked per day. To notify of an absence click the scheduled booking and select “Notify Absence”. You will be asked to confirm absence. If you select yes you will be asked to give a reason. When giving a reason please mention if it's for BSC, ASC or Both sessions. Possible reasons would be no longer required, Illness, Holiday etc. Please note that cancellations or changes of a permanent booking require a new CWA (Complying written Agreement) Booking form. These can be collected from OSHC.
- **Statements & Invoices –** Here you can see your history of invoices and payments. Please note that your fees are estimated if the rebates have not been applied prior to invoices being sent out. You will notice adjustments on your invoices if this occurs.

Thank you to all the families for your patience as we have been transitioning. Your support has been amazing!
