Thank you to Rosie for organising the teams and preparing the students for the day of competitions. Thank you also to all the parent volunteers, without your support these events could not occur.

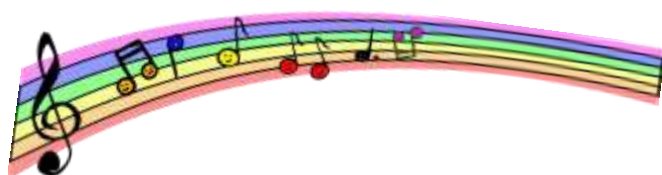
Play and Stay

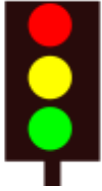
