Before and After School Supervision

Just a reminder that both before and after school, students need to be supervised by an adult to ensure their safety. Teachers do not begin morning duty until 8:30am. Therefore prior to 8:30am, unsupervised students need to attend OSHC and not be in our school yard.

After 3:00pm, if students are in the school yard they also need to be supervised by an adult. Teachers will be in the yard until 3:20pm but there is an expectation that students without adult supervision will be going to OSHC.
