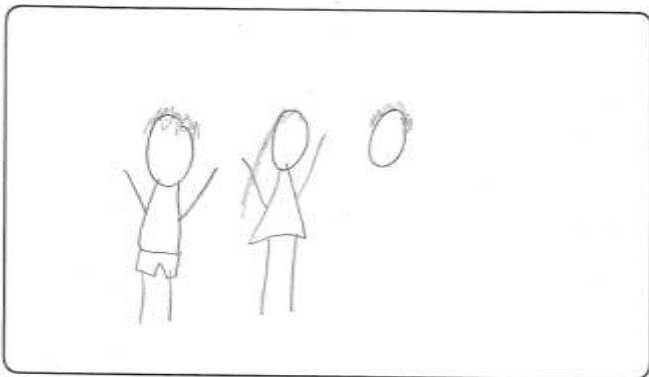

The performance celebrated and reinforced our NAPS values of kindness, resilience and respect while also addressing the challenging concept of racism.

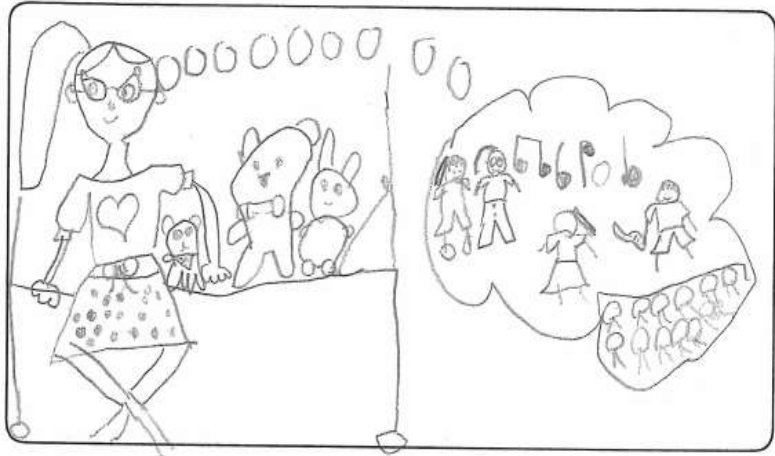
Students responded with positivity and enthusiasm to the performance's central message of kindness, harmony and inter-cultural respect and understanding.
