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FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome!

Welcome back to term 2. I hope you were able to stay safe and had an enjoyable break with your children! It has been lovely to have so many children back at school, there were definitely some excited faces on the first day back. We currently have approximately 75% of students returning to face to face learning.

I would like to thank our community for your support and warm wishes, they are so greatly appreciated.

We have very rapidly transitioned back to face-to-face learning and I would like to take this opportunity to thank our dedicated teachers who have worked tirelessly to prepare quality learning opportunities for students. Teachers will continue to provide learning opportunities for both their students in the classroom and online. Trying to maintain two platforms for learning is difficult and so please be understanding and support teachers with their endeavours.

Throughout this period it is important that we keep our community safe and therefore we will continue to implement the same processes and procedures that we had in place at the end of last term. Please do not enter the school grounds unless there is an emergency. Any visitors to the school will need to complete a site entry form as per the Department's processes. Parents can contact the front office and teachers via phone, email or through the online platforms. Whilst there are currently low rates of COVID-19 in South Australia we have a large number of people on site and therefore can't afford for the virus to enter the school. In the interests of being careful we will still adhere to the following guidelines:

- Assemblies will be postponed until further notice.
- School banking will be postponed and uniform shop will continue to be closed.
- The selling of ice blocks will be postponed.
- Water fountains will still be not operating so please make sure your child brings a water bottle to school.
- Continued hand hygiene practices will be occurring in all classrooms.
- We will continue the increased cleaning of our site. This term our playground equipment will also be cleaned daily.



Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell. Students displaying coughs, temperatures, breathing problems or flu like symptoms will be sent home. In addition there are likely to be more staff absence than usual this term as staff will be staying home if they are at all sick. It is important that our community is as healthy as possible during this period.
