FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Carers,



We are looking forward to easing some of our restrictions next term. As of July the 20th, the first day of term 3, parents will be able to come onto school grounds, but not into classrooms. We are looking forward to parents being in our yard again as we have missed the community feel of the school. We are very thankful that we have students back at school and focused on learning and really want to make sure that we don't revert back to a situation where home schooling needs to occur. Consequently when on school grounds next term please maintain social distancing and don't enter school grounds if you are unwell.

One of the positive outcomes of COVID19 has been the independence developed by our younger students, and we are particularly proud of our reception children, who have been taking themselves to class and organising their belongings at the beginning of the day. We are very keen for this to continue, so please be mindful that many children are now able to independently organise themselves and may not need much help at the beginning of the day.



Reports

Mid-Year Progress Reports will be going home next week. Teachers have been busy writing these reports which will provide a formative assessment of your child's progress for the first half of the year. All students from Year 1 to Year 7 will be provided with an A to E grade. Obviously there has been disruptions to our usual teaching due to COVID-19. As a result reports may contain some non-submitted (NS) or non-applicable (NA) grades. Non-submitted means that students have not completed some work. This may have occurred whilst they were participating in online learning. Not applicable means there is not enough evidence in this area for students to receive a grade in their mid-year report and so their final grade in this subject will be in the end of year report.

Please remember that a 'C' grade is the expected achievement at your child's year level. Your child will also be given a grade for their effort and this is important to discuss with children as it will indicate whether your child is doing the best they can do.

OSHC/ Vacation Care Charges

On 8th of June the Government announced that the Childcare relief package will end on the 12th of July 2020. Resumption of OSHC charges and Child Care Subsidy will start from the 13th of July 2020. Charges will remain the same as they were pre COVID-19. **OSHC families will therefore be charged fees from Monday 13th of July** (2nd week of Vacation Care). For Families that have been impacted by COVID-19 the CCS activity test requirements will be eased for 12 weeks from 13th of July 2020 to 4th of October 2020. Families will need to contact Centrelink to find out more about this.



Early Dismissal

Students will also be dismissed at 2pm on Friday the 3rd of July as it is the last day of term.

Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD)

NAPS will once again be collecting information for the NCCD. All schools are required to collect information about the numbers of students that they provide adjustments to under the Disability Discrimination Act (1992) and Disability Standards of Education. This data is used as the basis for national funding.

The NCCD involves the collection of;

- the number of students receiving adjustments to enable them to participate in education on the same basis as other students
- the level of adjustment provided to students
- student's type of disability if known

Under the model the definition of disability is broad and includes learning difficulties, health and mental health conditions.

If your child is identified for inclusion in the collection, the required information will be included in this year's data collection.

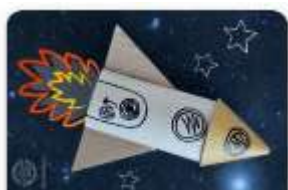

URGENT INFORMATION RELEASE – CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

- 2020 SEASON CANCELLED

Attention Member Schools & Delegates

The North West Junior Soccer Association Board regrets to announce it has decided to cancel it's 2020 football (soccer) season.

This has occurred after lengthy consideration and in consultation with SA Health, Local Government, Sport SA and our Insurance provider.

The decision was based on:

- Children not receiving fair opportunity to play due to the reduction to the number of teams that we would normally be able to accommodate. This is due to the compliance requirements of spacing games resulting in a reduced number of games able to be programmed.
- Running large venues requires complex supervision. We are unable to sufficiently supervise these venues in the current COVID-19 environment to the required compliance level.
- Inability to provide insurance that would enable support in pandemic conditions

There will be no AGM for season 2020.

Please be assured that NWJSA is committed to offering the 2021 season and looks forward to next year.

We know this is a difficult decision and we thank-you for your continued support.
