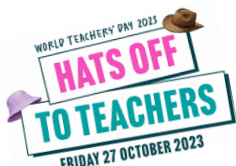
FROM THE PRINCIPAL

STATE CHESS CHAMPIONS AT NAPS!

The North Adelaide Primary School Chess Club has been extremely successful this year and we should be extremely proud as a school community.

For the second year running, we won both the A grade Championships and the Evelyn Koshnitsky Shield, for the best primary school in South Australia. This is the highest level of State Primary school competition in South Australia and to win two years in a row is a testament to student achievement and the high quality of coaching we have at NAPS - Luke Errington, Robert Kronitis, and Alex and James Moore.

The final results for the Evelyn Koshnitsky Shield were:

2. East Marden PS
3. Prince Alfred College
4. Linden Park PS
5. St Peter's College

Congratulations to the team members: Quan, Jude E, Sharvi, Grace E, Jacky, Hai, Kritika, Nick F, Sam C, Armin, and Laurence.

The B and C grade teams also ranked highly enough during the interschool competitions throughout the year to be invited to attend the B and C grade finals. North Adelaide Yellow came 5th in B grade, North Adelaide Green came 4th and North Adelaide Blue came 9th in C grade.

North Adelaide Primary School will now represent South Australia in the National Schools Teams Championships, to be played here in Adelaide in term 4.

There have also been a number of brilliant individual results. The State Championships were held in the school holidays at the Chess Centre in the CBD.

Jude E - 2nd (Under 10); Laurence - 1st (Under 9 – State Champion); Edward M - 2nd (Under 7); Daniel F - 3rd (Under 7).

This term the School Chess Championships is being held after school in the music room, with 50 students already registered. While a knowledge of the rules is required, it is a great way to test out if chess is a passion for your child before trials for the chess club begin again in term 1 2024. Come and give it a try!


